General Definition of work:

Performs a variety of duties and responsibilities such as recording pump run times taking flow pressure measurements. Troubleshoots pumps and floats. Assists with the maintenance and repair of machinery and equipment in the lift station department.

Essential Job Functions, Duties and Responsibilities:

- Monitors bio-remediation dosages to acquire proper lift station grease and odor control.
- Inspects and monitors lift station equipment to maintain adequate pumping conditions.
- May collect and tests raw sewage samples according to TCEQ, EPA and District standards.
- Assists with minor/major repairs or replacement of lift station equipment.
- Performs general repairs as needed.
- Records pumping data such as pump run time readings on a daily basis.
- Performs other related duties as assigned to enhance the overall operation and services of the lift stations.
- Must adhere to all safety policies and procedures.

Requirements:

- Job requires a diploma from an accredited high school or GED equivalent.
- District may hire Lift Station Operator Trainee with no previous work experience.
- Must be able to obtain a TCEQ Wastewater Class D within one year of employment and a Wastewater Class C within two years of employment.
- Required to work weekends on a rotating schedule.
- Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License Class C.
- Must have basic computer and data entry skills
- Must be able to lift 50 pounds and pass a fit for duty physical examination.
